As you may know, for various reasons Cedar Falls Utilities has found it necessary to discontinue support of the email platform, @cfu.net. This means that all @cfu.net accounts will need to transition to something else. Since most people are moving to Gmail, we are planning a workshop in an attempt to provide assistance as our friends work through this change. This workshop is a collaboration with Cedar Falls Utilities, the Cedar Falls Public Library, and Orchard Hill's IT department. Thank you to Kent Halder, Kristi Anhalt and Alex Frerking for helping us put it together!

The plan is to gather in the OHC Commons at 1pm on Tuesday, November 12. You will receive general information about the process and then break into small groups to actually work on opening a gmail account, setting it up, and/or migrating selected messages from @cfu.net to @gmail.com. For this endeavor to be successful, we must require advance reservations so we can recruit enough coaches. All are welcome to attend for the general information and handouts outlining the process. If you would like hands-on assistance, we must have your reservation by noon on Friday, November 8. It will be best if you can bring a laptop computer. Setting up auto-forwarding, auto-responses and other advanced options cannot be done using mobile devices like phones or tablets. We may be able to arrange for a few laptops.

Please contact me to make your reservation and be prepared to tell us the following:

- 1. Will you be bringing your own laptop computer? If so, is it a Mac or PC?
- 2. Have you created a gmail account yet? If you are able to do so before our session, it will speed things up but we understand if you cannot. We'll help you with that.
- 3. Please be sure to bring your email and CFU passwords with you so you can access your accounts.

As you can imagine, we will have a much better idea of how the flow will work once we know how many reservations we receive. We hope/know you will give us grace as we figure it all out! Our hope is that after our workshop you will be up and running with your new email account. At the very least, you will become more knowledgeable about the process. If you are unavailable on November 12 or find that you need additional assistance, you can schedule a follow-up appointment with the reference department at the Cedar Falls Public Library by calling 319-268-5543.

Ed and Sally Baker have presented Bible Study sessions for four weeks. Thank you so much!


